

Study Mobility Report and Study Mobility Poster

Dear student,

In order to finalize your exchange / international study mobility with MIAS (Masaryk Institute of Advanced Studies) you are obliged to submit study mobility documents based on CTU requirements see <http://www.muvs.cvut.cz/student/studium-v-zahranici/>, a Study Mobility Report and a Study Mobility Poster.

The Report and Poster are completion requirements for your course G88E0205 (Zahraniční praxe) for BSc Degree students or U88E0205 (Zahraniční praxe) for MSc Degree students at MIAS which will be granted 6 ECTS credits on a Pass/Fail basis.

The Report and Poster are to be submitted electronically, together with the other documents required to the ERASMUS academic coordinator within a month after the termination of the student's mobility stay.

Study Mobility Report

Minimum length of 1,000 words and maximum of 2,000 words.

The recommended structure:

- 1. Personal information** - First name, Last name, Student number, Email address
- 2. Host University** - Name of host University, Faculty / Institute, Location (country and city)
 - exchange at the host university (type of mobility, field of study, courses, projects etc.) description
 - level of education at the host university description (compared to MIAS or any other education experience)
 - the level of satisfaction with the host university exchange organization
 - overview of experiences, challenges and issues encountered during the stay
 - social life and accommodation experiences description
 - housing and social live recommendations and tips for future exchange students at the same location
- 3. Home University (CTU/MIAS)**
 - the level of satisfaction with the pre-mobility procedures and support provided by the International Office of CTU (rektorát) description
 - the level of satisfaction with the pre-mobility support provided by the International Office of MIAS description



Study Mobility Poster

You will create the poster in creative, attractive artwork which will be printed as A3 format or shared electronically as *.pdf file.

1. The structure and content of the poster:

- **Personal information** - First name, Last name, Study programme at MIAS, year of study
- **Host University** - Name of host University, Faculty / Institute, Location (city and country)
- **Three key impressions and benefits** from point of view of MIAS student (related e.g. to educational experience, housing, social and multicultural interactions etc.), 3 – 4 lines of description for each
- **Photos** (4 – 10 pictures) related to the city, University location and your impressions and benefits (above)

2. Creating the poster recommendation

For the poster creation you might use any program / application with export to *.pdf.

We recommend a simple and free software available online - Lucidpress.

For students registered through their school e-mail is Lucidpress free. You can register for the program without school e-mail, but you will be limited to 100 MB (compared to 1 GB) and you will not be able to download a PDF of full quality. For this reason, we recommend registering through the school e-mail at:
