Innovation leadership for industry

AIM OF THE COURSE: By the end of the course students will gain thorough knowledge and acquire practical skills related to innovation leadership. They will focus on the complete process of developing innovations from generating new ideas to successful strategies utilized to create value for the companies and their customers.

EXTENT: 56 hours in total (in class, project preparation, company visits, project presentation). Students will submit and present a project related to the topic.

AIM OF THE COURSE: By the end of the International Summer School students will get acquainted with the most interesting periods of Czech history, the City of Prague and other notable places. They will understand the local traditions, habits and culture. As a result of their frequent visits and references by locals, students will become well oriented, thus improving the satisfaction of spending more time in the city by themselves.

EXTENT: An introductory session, events experiencing the Prague City and culture, field trips to other locations in the country and more. Students will submit an essay in the third week and attend a debriefing session.
