The CTU MIAS School of Business invites you to participate in the **Third Annual Albín Bráf Student Conference**, to be held **on May 30, 2018 in Prague**. We thus take up the long tradition in teaching economics at the Czech Technical University in Prague, associated with the name of the eminent Czech economist Albín Bráf (1851 - 1912).

Undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate students in economics, management and other interdisciplinary programs taught at technical universities are herewith offered an opportunity to present and discuss their research results, experience the topics, methods and applications implemented at different institutions, as well as to share insights and establish new contacts.

Papers received in English, Czech or Slovak will be peer-reviewed and published in the **Conference Proceedings**, and - upon presentation in conference sections - the best papers by students will be rewarded. Upon previous approval by the Organizing Committee, presentations of accepted papers by participants outside the CTU may take the form of **posters**.

Preliminary **registrations**, including the names of the student and his academic advisor, school, study program and paper title should be submitted by **March 18, 2018** to braf@muvs.cvut.cz, where applicants will receive further information on conference organization and paper format. Submission of full papers for review will then be expected by **April 16, 2018**.

Besides specialized sections, the Conference program in 2018 will include two panels, focusing on current issues in **education internationalization**, and **logistics and supply chain management**.

Thanks to the generous support of the Czech Technical University in Prague and the International Visegrad Fund, student participants will be granted full relief of registration fees.
