GOAL OF THE PROJECT

The project introduces the world of business to university students, offering them an opportunity to test their theoretical knowledge by solving real business tasks in an international environment. In this way, students are offered better chances in their professional lives.

WHAT IS IT?

The **INTERNATIONAL PROJECT WORKSHOP (IPW)** is an international project of MIAS CTU and its partner universities. It combines university education and work experience. Its uniqueness lies in the fact that students work in teams and complete real tasks designed for them by representatives of major international companies.

WHICH COMPANIES ARE INCLUDED?

Mostly multinational companies based in the same countries as the universities.

FOR WHOM IS THE PROJECT INTENDED?

Students from Bachelor degree programmes with a focus on economics and management.

HOW ARE STUDENTS SELECTED?

The students have to show their commitment and motivation. They are carefully selected by a panel on the basis of their CV, motivation letter and interview. The admission procedure has two stages.
