2-week interdisciplinary Winter school exploring the challenges of the decolonization of cultural heritage from Italy and Europe to Africa, focussing on three areas: languages, figurative arts (and museum studies), and music.



TARGET

Senior undergraduate and graduate international students from any background related to humanities, social and economic studies, with an interest in the cultural heritage, international issues and local and national identities. Good level of English needed (B2).

 - » the conflict between hegemonic languages and local languages (linguistic focus);
 - » the restitution and re-appropriation of material cultural heritage (focus on figurative arts and museum studies);
 - » the overcoming of colonialist exoticism through the metabolization of local musical traditions (musicological focus).
